Willkie Says U. S. Must Avoid War

NEW YORK, June 18.—(AP)—Willkie said today without qualification that in his opinion "we must stay out of the war" to best serve the cause of democracy.

Without mentioning President Roosevelt by name or any action that he has taken, Willkie, a candidate for the republican presidential nomination, added:

"No man has the right to use the great powers of the presidency to lead the people, indirectly, into war; only the people through their elected representatives can make that awful decision and there is no question as to their decision."

He spoke before 1,200 persons at a gathering sponsored by the young republican clubs of Brook-
