SALEM, July 5.—(AP)—Shares of stock held in an Oregon bank and owned by the state of an out-of-state resident are not subject to Oregon inheritance tax laws, but are taxable by the state in which the owner lived, the attorney general ruled.

PORTLAND, July 5.—(AP)—The Pool Trades Institute announces there will be no Sunday closing proposal on the November general election ballot.
