

Ornery Lad Likely To Prove Success

'Bad Egg' Nearly Always More Capable Than Ordinary Boy, Ex-Employer Declares.

DES MOINES, Ia.—(AP)—Cheer up if your young son is an ornery little troublemaker.

Homer White of Des Moines says such a lad is more apt to be a success as an adult than if he didn't pick on the neighbors' kids. And Homer ought to know. He has had more than 10,000 boys under his wing at one time or another during his 52 years with the Western Union.

White, veteran district telegraph supervisor here, said he never yet has found a boy who was "wholly bad."

Millions of American parents will say "amen" to his next conclusion. "There isn't any set rule by which you can handle boys," he said. "God didn't make any two of them alike."

Nevertheless, he added, long experience has taught him the truth of these generalizations:

1. Almost invariably, the "bad egg" is more capable than his companions and therefore is "subject to development beyond the possibilities of the ordinary boy."

2. If you win a boy's confidence, he won't try your patience. "But if you try to control his activities without first getting him on your side, he will drive you nuts."

3. "Draw upon your own personal experience as a boy and show him you understand his problems and are willing to help him solve them."

Not once in his half century of dealing with the younger generation has he found it necessary to turn one of his boys over to the police, he says.

White is continually being surprised at where his former messengers turn up. One is a district judge. Several hold responsible positions in Illinois and Iowa industries, he said, and he climbed into a cab the other night to discover the driver had been one of his messengers 25 years ago.

Foreign National Insurance by British Housewife

SALEM, Ore.—(UP)—There are 52 foreign nation insurance companies operating in the state, the 32nd annual report of the state insurance commissioner shows.

Of the total, 42 are fire companies, seven casualty and three are life insurance firms.

Haakon Refuses To Renounce Kingship

LONDON, July 8.—(AP)—(via radio)—Hakon, exiled king of Norway, asserted in a broadcast from Buckingham palace today that in refusing to abdicate he felt sure he was acting "in conformity with the wishes of the Norwegian people."

"My motto has always been and forever will be: everything for Norway."

"It would grieve me deeply if I were separated from Norway," he added, but said he would take such a step if he believed it the wish of the Norwegian people and the Norwegian government.

Haakon declared that the Norwegian constitution provided that the king "may stay up to six months outside the kingdom without the consent of the parliament" and added that the starting had given permission for the king to leave the country, if necessary, without setting a time limit.

The present Norwegian administration in Oslo which demanded his resignation was German-dominated, he said, and did not represent the will of the people. He and his government, he went on, would prefer to return to their country and carry out their proper functions but the first requisite "for our return must be that the German military leave the country."

"As long as this is not the case, a free and independent Norwegian government can exist only outside the limits of Norway."

"If the king and the government were to return for the benefit of the state council and the Germans, Norway would no longer be able to control her most important economic interests abroad, now taken

care of by the present government." (In England).

He concluded with the statement that he believed his refusal to abdicate "would be understood and respected by everyone in all freedom-loving countries."

Nazi Aviator Captured by British Housewife

LONDON, July 8.—(AP)—A British housewife yesterday captured a German aviator who parachuted to earth in northeast England after his plane was shot down in a battle with British Spitfire fighters.

Mrs. Nora Canrdwell saw him

landing in front of her home.

"I went up to him," she said, "and told him to put up his hands and said, 'I want it,' pointing to his revolver."

"He unbuckled it and handed it to me and I marched him to the backyard where some motorcyclists came along and took charge of him."

Bouchard Sentenced to Die for Double Murder

EVERETT, July 8.—(AP)—Edward L. Bouchard, convicted of the slaying of Cyril Ables and Ralph Allison, both of southern California, will pay the extreme penalty at Walla Walla penitentiary Sept. 6. This was the execution date set yesterday by Superior Judge Bell after the court had denied de-

fense motion for a new trial. Ables and Allison were found slain in the woods near Arlington last October. This is said to be the first time that a defendant in this state has been tried, convicted and sentenced on more than one count of first degree murder.

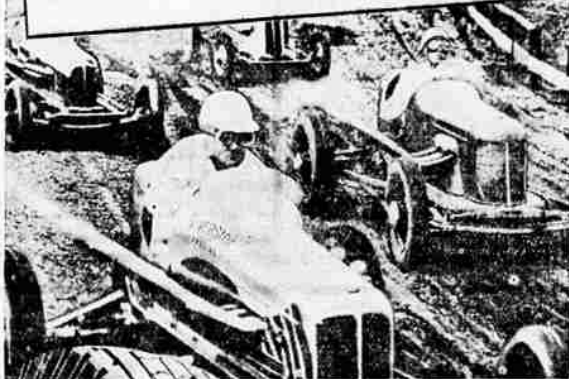

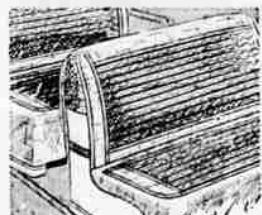

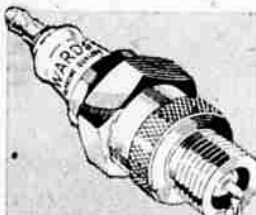
