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British Repulse Nazis' Raid of Eighty Planes

that it was coming straight for us and we threw ourselves into a hedge," said one spectator.

"The plane hit a low brick wall and ploughed across the field where we had been standing. It burst quickly into flames and I saw one German throw his comrades out. The man had a broken leg."

Invasion Plans Upset

The raids came as Britain claimed victory in the first major phase of the 5-week-old struggle against Nazi conquest of England—by repeated, violent attacks on German "blitzkrieg bases" across the channel and at the same time tightening her blockade of the reich.

With more than 1,600 mass air raids, a London spokesman said, the British royal air force now has "made it extremely difficult for Germany to organize massed attacks on this country from air-dromes in Holland, Belgium and France, or from bases the enemy hoped to establish in Norway."

The spokesman said the RAF, although numerically outnumbered by German warplanes, had "to a great extent succeeded in breaking down" Hitler's scheme for a cross-channel invasion of the British Isles and had made her new air bases "acquired nearer our shores practically untenable."

"These violent, non-stop onslaughts are making the enemy reel under hammer blows," he said. "The British report, taken at face value, might at least partially explain the mystery of Hitler's delay in launching his long-threatened blitzkrieg on Britain."

Another possible reason was advanced by the London Daily Telegraph. Quoting "the most reliable neutral sources," the newspaper said a serious difference of opinion among Hitler's advisers was holding up the projected invasion.

Britains Eager To Foot Bill

The British people's will to victory appeared in a stronger light than ever today when the \$13,868,000 budget of Chancellor of the Exchequer Wood—based upon the heaviest taxation in British history—was condemned as "timid and inadequate."

With one accord, the London press clamored for "a real war budget" despite the fact that Britons are already paying a 42 1/2 per cent income tax.

The question of oil for Germany shared interest with attacks on the "puny" budget.

The Financial Times in London declared the British government "will want definite assurances from Spain that oil supplies do not go to Germany."

Hitler's need of oil and still more oil to fuel and lubricate his mechanized war machine was pointed out yesterday when the pro-Nazi Rumanian government seized the biggest British oil company in the Balkan kingdom. The confiscated oil may now go to Germany.

Rome Feels Food Lack

Italians also began to feel the pinch of the British blockade as Mussolini's government decreed still another meatless day—making four "vegetarian days" a week—and ordered sharp rationing of bread in restaurants.

American-made dive-bombers, export models of planes used by the U. S. navy, are being used by German sky raiders in pounding Eng-

land, the British disclosed. The British air ministry said today American type planes were apparently captured by the Nazis from the French.

The war struck again yesterday at the Holy Land, held under British mandate, with a toll of 46 civilian dead and 80 wounded when ten planes, presumably Italian, dropped 80 to 100 high explosives into the streets and harbor of the port of Haifa.

BERLIN, July 25.—(AP)—Bombing of the British Vickers aircraft factory at Weybridge, 12 miles from the southwestern outskirts of London was announced today by the German high command.

Ten British planes were shot down or wrecked in the day's operations, the high command said, including four which were destroyed on the grounds at the Vickers works. The loss of six German planes was acknowledged.

Besides the attacks on the airplane factory, bombing raids were carried out on British industrial plants at Great Yarmouth and Glasgow in Scotland, the Germans said.

Wentworth confirmed stoppage of two shipments of oil to Spain.

The other amendments to the law and regulations issued last July 2 designed to keep in this country materials essential to the national defense.

The law these regulations implemented provided legal authority for the control of exports of munitions, materials and machinery needed for defense.

Stephen Early, presidential secretary, said the order did not mean an embargo was being placed on these products but that the authority merely was being provided to control shipments to other countries.

While Morgenthau would supply no reasons for the oil shipment stoppages, it was learned elsewhere that a virtual embargo already had been established to prevent the oil from reaching Germany and Italy through Spain.
