TOKYO, Sept. 13.—(AP)—The newspaper Kokumin, often a spokesman for the army, asserted today that the Japanese government was making special efforts to reach an understanding with Soviet Russia on the ground that the United States' preparedness program is directed at Japan.

A rapprochement is being sought in order to safeguard Japan's rear because, the newspaper said, relations between the United States and Japan are "fraught with the danger of war."

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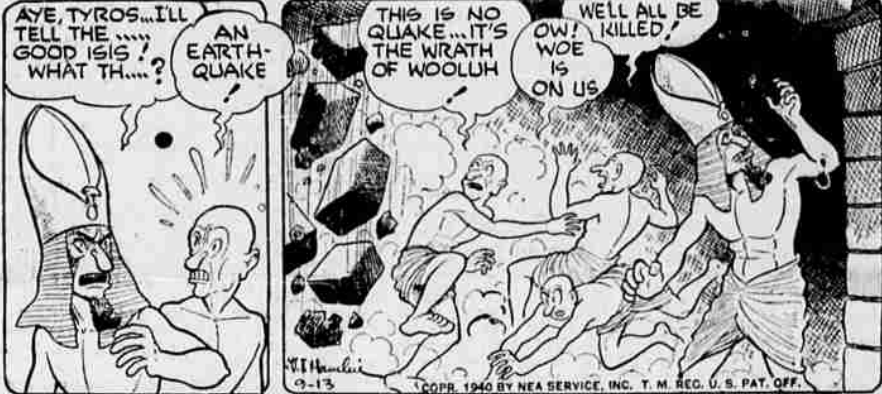
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
