SALEM, Nov. 12—(AP)—Governor Charles A. Sprague proclaimed today the twenty-first day of November as Thanksgiving day in Oregon.

The date, a week earlier than customary, is the same as that fixed by President Roosevelt. That day will be Thanksgiving day in about three-fourths of the states, with the others observing it on November 28.
