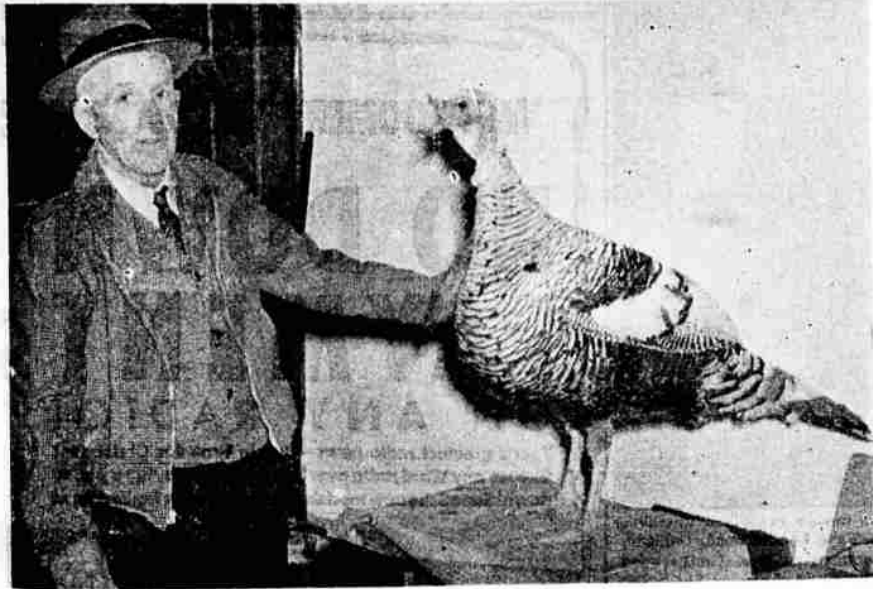

Domes, Grower of White Hollands, To Compete in 1941

Henry W. Domes of Rickreall, winner of six grand championships at the Northwestern Turkey show, is serving notice that he will be back in competition with his White Holland turkeys at the 1941 show.

Mr. Domes has exhibited in the utility division for the past two years, but states he will have 40 or more birds in readiness for next year's show.

His entries in the 1939 World's Poultry congress at Cleveland, Ohio, in 1939, won all prizes in the White Holland division and the grand championship of the show, making a clean sweep of all available honors. In addition to taking six grand championships at the Northwestern Turkey show he has won principal honors in numerous other exhibits, including the grand championship at Grand Forks, North Dakota, poultry show. His numerous winnings have made him widely known throughout the nation as one of the country's foremost breeders and has resulted in the establishing of a very large business in brood stock and eggs.

He produces about 5,000 birds each year on his 250-acre farm. He has been engaged in the turkey business for about 14 years.

His son, Richard, 22, is joining in the business and will be a joint exhibitor in 1941, Mr. Domes states.

Guards are maintained day and night at Turkey hall during the annual show to care for the birds, break up fights and keep the temperature right.
