Safety Driving League Launches War On Hazards

AMES, Ia., Dec. 27.—(Special)—With winter conditions prevailing in most sections of thirty-three northern states, safety authorities today issued motorists to be extra careful and take practical precautions in battling "Old Man Winter."

Declaring that November to March is the most crucial time in the year for motorist safety... A previous study of accident records proved skidding as the chief cause of winter accidents.

The following winter driving hazards and the vital safety practices in each instance, provide a handy condensed formula for protecting pedestrians, other motorists, your car and yourself.

and ice conditions has been proven a fallacy, since it gives very little added traction and increases instability and tendency to skid on curves.

2. Without chains even good tire treads slip and slide on snow or ice. Chains bite into hard-packed snow or icy road surface.

3. Windshield wipers and defrosters that don't operate lead to winter accidents. Make sure wipers and defrosters are in good working order.

4. Faulty headlights are prime causes of winter accidents, 1940-41 cars with sealed-beam headlights add to safety.

5. High speeds on snow or ice are doubly dangerous. Adjust your speed to conditions. Even when protected with chains, speeds should be reduced from those considered reasonable on dry pavements.

6. "Crowdins," other vehicles ahead of you or at your side is criminal carelessness on snow covered pavement.

7. Sudden slowdowns and stops are a primary cause of skidding and spinning. Slow down gradually in gear and "pump" brakes on-off-and-on to keep wheels from locking.

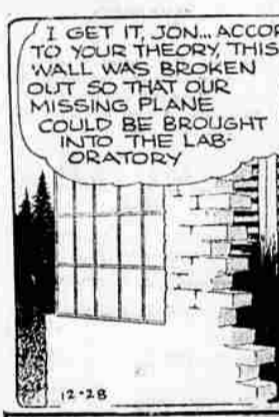
