Husband, 21, Confesses He Killed Wife, Aged 35

CHEHALIS, Wash., Jan. 1.—(AP)—Prosecutor's Deputy Lloyd Dyaart of Lewis county announced today Frank Wilhelm Turner, 21, was held here without charge after admitting he killed his wife, Anne, about 35, during a quarrel.

Dyaart said the body of Mrs.

Turner was found today at the Turner home in Sheehy valley, 30 miles east of here. He reported she had been shot to death Monday night.

The deputy prosecutor said Turner gave no reason for his action, except that the couple quarrelled.

Dyaart said Turner's father is Maj. Frank P. Turner, U. S. cavalry, Denver, and his mother is Mrs. K. Salter, Chicago.

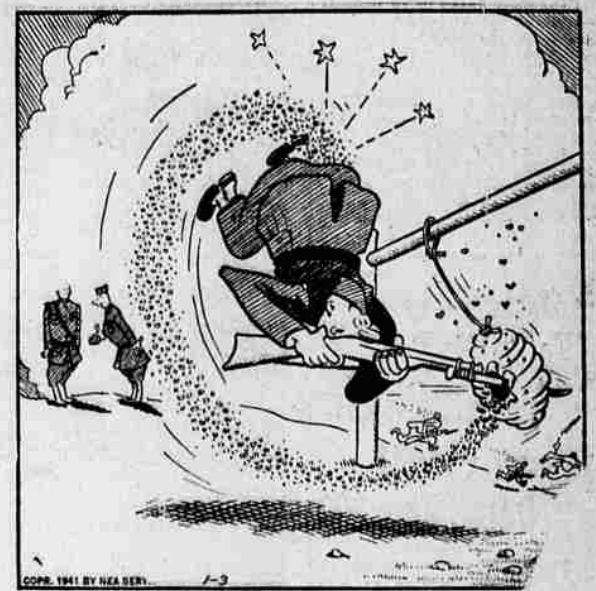

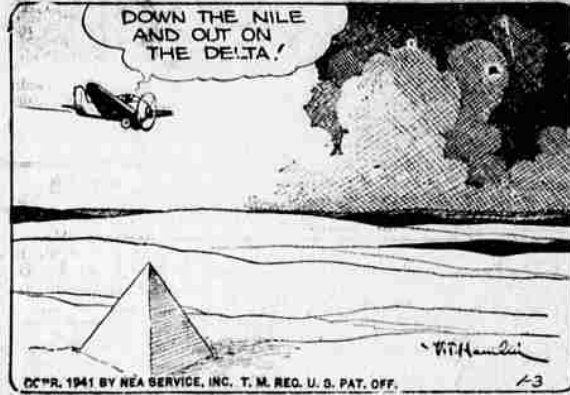

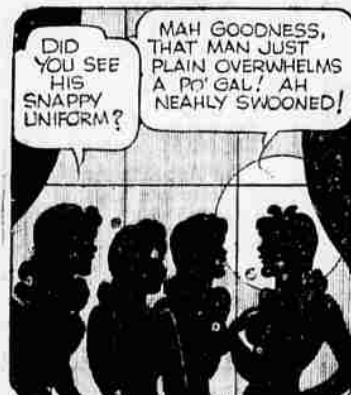
