Cougars Closer to Basketball Title

Washington State Cougars are practically the 1941 champions of the Pacific coast conference, northern division basketball race.

The Cougars all but won the title when they defeated the Washington Huskies 39-31 Saturday night in Seattle for their ninth consecutive victory. It was the Huskies' sixth straight loss.

The Cougars now have a record of nine victories against only two defeats. Their nearest foes are the Oregon Webfoots who have won six and lost six, and the Oregon State Beavers who have won four and lost four.

The Webfoots, who got a late start on the victory trail, defeated Idaho 52-28, to make it two in a row, over the Vandals Saturday night.

The Vandals moved from Eugene to Corvallis tonight to open a two-game series against the Beavers. Other games this week bring the Huskies and Cougars together in Pullman Friday and Saturday nights and Oregon and Oregon State at Corvallis Saturday night.
