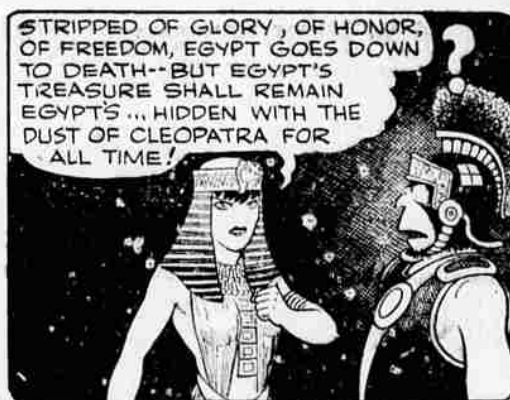
American Journalist Ordered to Quit Italy

ROME, Feb. 26.—(AP)—The ministry of popular culture today asked John T. Whitaker, correspondent of the Chicago Daily

News, to leave Italy. Whitaker said he was advised through the United States embassy that the ministry wished him to leave within ten days "because of the number and importance of his contacts and the unfriendly attitude of his newspaper," and also because the tone of his dispatches had been displeasing.

CHICAGO, Feb. 26.—(AP)—Carroll Binder, foreign editor of the Chicago Daily News, said today that Italy, by requesting John T. Whitaker to leave the country, had "served notice on the world that it will no longer tolerate independent reporting of its activities in the American press."

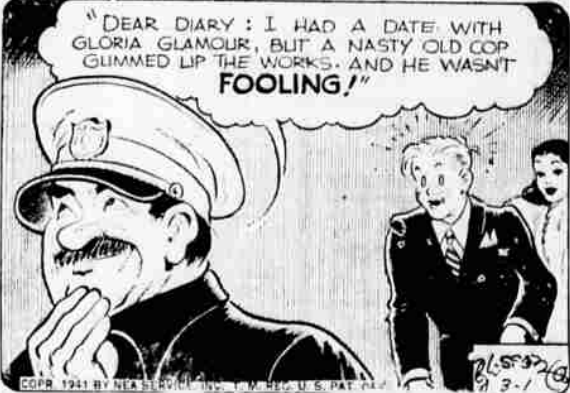

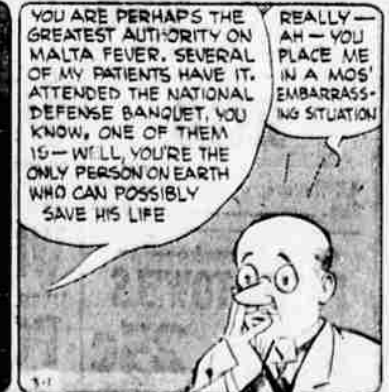
