Salmon Fishing Control in Ocean Urged on Board

WASHINGTON, March 13.—(AP)—A memorial from the Oregon legislature asked congress last Saturday to amend the international salmon treaty to give the commission jurisdiction over silver and chinook salmon outside state waters. It would provide the commission include in its investigation "all species of salmon in outside waters from the state of California to Cape Scott on Vancouver island and that such fishing in such waters commercially come under the jurisdiction and regulations of the said commission to the end that there shall be proper protection and conservation of the fish."

The memorial recited that outside fishing operations catch a substantial portion of the silver and chinook salmon originating from the streams of Oregon, Washington and British Columbia. It said this fishing was entirely unregulated with the fish-

Sutherland Has Prospect Of New Lumber Mill

SUTHERLIN, Ore., March 12.—William Schofield, representing Julio Metal of Santa Monica, Calif., appeared before a special meeting of the city council Monday evening, March 10, to discuss means of acquiring certain parcels of land for a lumber mill site.

Satisfactory agreements were reached whereby Mr. Metal may acquire an option by posting a "good faith bond" of \$100 to insure immediate starting of construction. The proposed mill will be of approximately 25 to 50 M feet per day capacity and incorporate a planing mill as well. A telegram from Mr. Metal giving the "go ahead" signal is expected at once.
