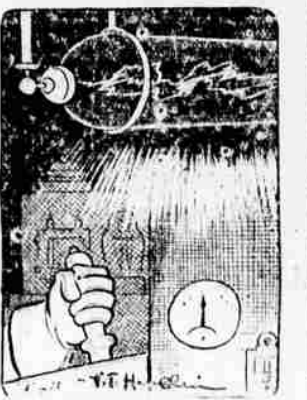

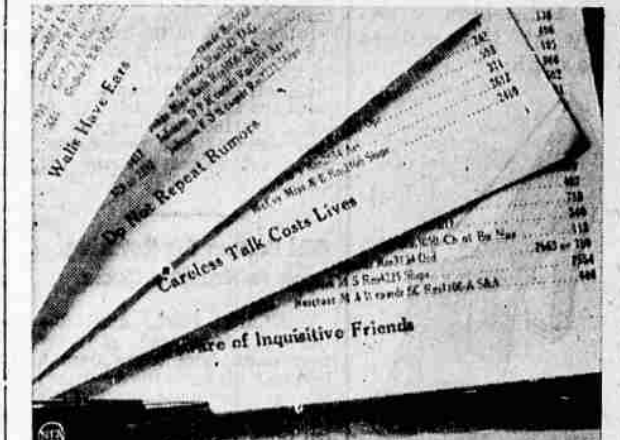


Photo shows admonitions against loose telephone talk printed at bottom of pages in new Navy Department telephone directory.
