**Morals Case Put In Hands of Jury**

The case of the State of Oregon against Phillip Tracy, indicted by the grand jury on a charge of contributing to the delinquency of a minor, was placed in the hands of the circuit court jury shortly before noon today. The case was heard yesterday and this morning, with Tracy claiming innocence.

The state's principal witness was Tracy's minor daughter, who charged improper advances. The defendant claimed that the girl's story was fabricated because she was dissatisfied with conditions at their remote home on upper Smith river.

The suit of J. F. Hogan against L. J. Fullerton, an action for damages alleged due as the result of an automobile accident, was scheduled to start this afternoon. It will be the last case to be heard by the jury at the present time, but it is expected the jury will be recalled in June to hear civil actions expected to be ready for trial at that time.

**Many Drivers Apply For License Renewals**

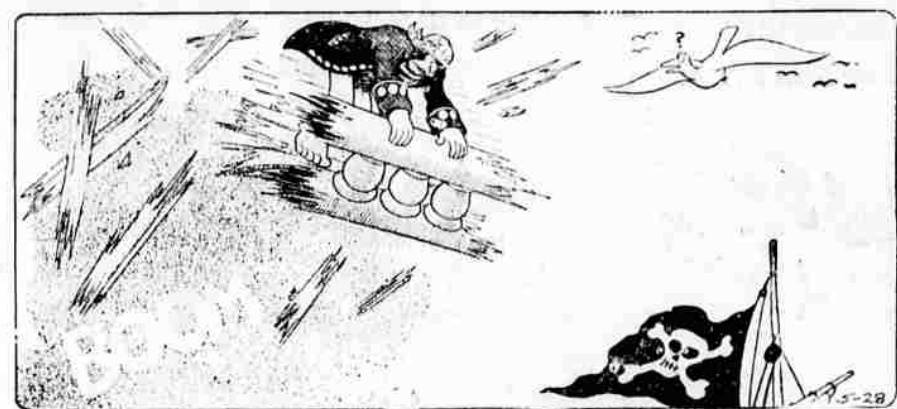
