To the defendants above named: You and each of you are hereby notified that application has this 15th day of July, 1941, been filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, State of Oregon, for judgment and decree of the said Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Douglas County, foreclosing the tax liens appearing in the foreclosure list of said Douglas County, Oregon; and that each of the properties described in said foreclosure list, unless redeemed in the manner provided by law, will be sold to Douglas county, Oregon, for the respective amounts of taxes and interest for which such properties severally are liable:

That any persons interested in any of the real property included in the foreclosure list are hereby required to appear and file an answer and defense to said application for judgment and decree within thirty (30) days after the date of the first publication of said foreclosure list, exclusive of the day of said first publication. Such answer and defense shall be in writing under oath and shall specify the particular cause of objection; and on failure so to do, plaintiff will apply, at the expiration of said 30 days from this notice, to the Court for judgment and decree against you and against said property, foreclosing said property, delinquent taxes as provided by law.
