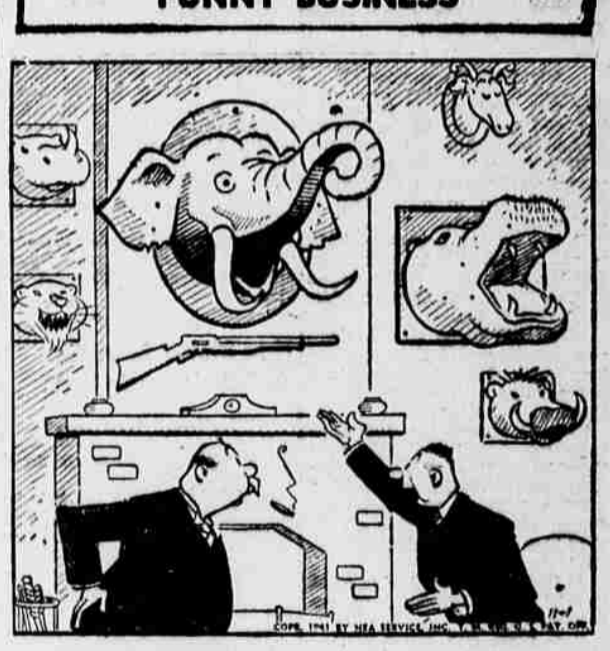
SUMMONS
