Promise of the Future

FOR what are Americans fight-
ing and sacrificing?
Many eloquent definitions of
the nation's war aims will be
made and many will be the state-
ments of varied individual aspira-
tions. But the signs seem to in-
dicate that the man in the street
has a very practical, down-to-
earth view of it all.

He is doing his part to defend
the country from attack and to
make it very tough for the at-
tackers. He is not thinking in
terms of protecting far-away
peoples. He is concerned with
his own world right here at home
—his family, his job, his prop-
erty and his future security. And
he will not be contented with that
world as he has known it during
the last painful ten years.

Writing in Nation's Business,
Benjamin H. Namn records the
significant answer of a cab driver
to whom Namn had remark-
ed:

"Well, I suppose you'll be glad
when the emergency is over and
we get back to normal times
again."

"Not me, mister," was the cab-
man's retort. "Back to 'normal'
times? Back to work relief and
home relief? If that is 'normal'
times, the emergency can go on
forever as far as I'm concerned."

There speaks that mythical en-
tity, the average American. Pre-
servation of American liberty and
American standards of the good
life? Yes, by all means—but some-
thing more than that. He is fight-
ing for the promise of the future,
for all that the republic and its
free institutions can mean in the
individual achievement of security
and happiness to those willing
to pay the price of those things.

Where Were Movie Gunmen?

Where was Hollywood's pioneer
stock while these holdups were
going on? Where were the mod-

Major Clement R. Atlee, speaking
as Churchill's deputy, tells the
house of commons the fact that
Britain's positions in the Pacific
are less strongly garrisoned and
equipped than could be wished is
not due to lack of foresight.

"Rather," he says, "it is because
it has been BEYOND BRITAIN'S
RESOURCES to be STRONG
EVERYWHERE."

He adds that at present the Jap-
anese have the MOST POWER-
FUL FLEET IN THE PACIFIC.

NO one as yet thinks the Japs
will be able to take Singa-
pore, one of the most strongly
defended citadels in the world.
But if they can ring it around
with airfields and untrained com-
mand of the air they may be able

to prevent its use as a base by the
American—British—Dutch naval
forces.

That is the real nub of the situ-
ation.

FROM everywhere the cry is
the same: "Give us airplanes!
Give us more airplanes. Give us
STILL MORE AIRPLANES!"

Until we can provide the
planes, we must be prepared for
bad news.

ON the other hand good news
comes from Africa, where
Hitler's battered armies are start-
ing a new retreat westward to-
ward Tripoli, and from Russia,
where the Germans are being
forced back farther from Mos-
cow and are facing the danger of
losing the Crimean peninsula en-
tirely.

INTERIOR Secretary Ickes tells
his press conference there is
no immediate prospect of gasoline
rationing. Tire rationing, he says,
is expected to make gasoline ra-
tioning unnecessary.

Tire rationing is estimated to
result in 35 per cent reduction in
civilian gas consumption, which
ought to be sufficient to meet the
situation.

He adds that a 40-mile speed
limit is being established at once
in the national parks and he
thinks it would be a good idea
if 40-mile limits were established
in all the states.

If that is done, he says, it
should be in the name of
rubber conservation, as excessive
speed is perhaps the chief cause
of excessive tire wear.

Adult Carpentry Class
Will Be Formed Here

Plans were announced today by
Bruce A. Mellis, trades coordina-
tor in the Roseburg high schools,
for formation of an adult class
in carpentry. Recent approval
by the war department for con-
struction of an army cantonment
at Medford will result in a wide-
spread demand for workers in the
building trades, Mr. Mellis as-
serts. It is estimated that 2,000
or more men will be needed for
a period of from three to four
months to complete the project.
Workers will include carpenters,
plumbers, electricians and help-
ers in each of these branches of
the building trades.

To assist local men in pre-
paring for jobs in connection with
cantonment construction, it is
planned to form a training class
here. It is requested that all men
interested in this course contact
W. M. Campbell, city superintendent
of schools; Frank Chase, man-
ager of the employment office, or
Mr. Mellis.

nated \$2 to be invested in stamps.
