Trial Dissatisfies Nazis
Marshal Petain's decision was announced soon after the Vichy government indefinitely suspended the Riom trial of French leaders charged with being responsible for France's unpreparedness for war.
Germany had complained bitterly that the trial failed to bring out France's "war guilt" for having taken up arms against the reich in the first place.
DNB, the official German news agency, said the decree suspending the trial meant that "the question of responsibility for the war will be raised" when and if the trial is resumed.

of axis tanks, armored cars and artillery in the Temrad sector, 60 miles across the desert no man's land from the main British positions at Tobruk.
An Italian communique said strong British columns, supported by armored units and artillery, were repulsed after fierce fighting.
"The enemy, which suffered heavy losses in killed and wounded, retreated," the Italian high command said.
A NORTHWEST TOWN IN ENGLAND, April 14—(AP)—Fourteen persons were killed, many others injured and considerable damage caused to residential property in German bombing attacks over scattered areas last night, it was announced today. Most of the raiders attacked towns near the coast, but one flew inland to northwest England. The German communique reported the raids were made on the Humber river estuary, where the principal towns are Hull and Girmbsy.

Blows On War Front
Other major developments in the European war theatre included:
1. Russian front—Russia's armies, pressing their furious winter-to-spring offensive, were reported to have launched an attack of extreme violence on the Moscow front.
British exchange telegraph quoted the Berlin radio as announcing that six soviet divisions (perhaps 90,000 troops), including an entire tank division, succeeded in dislodging German lines at some points and that the battle was still in progress.
The broadcast also said the Russians were attacking in the Donets basin on the southern (Ukraine) front, where the red armies have been driving against Kharkov, Taganrog and Dnieperopetrovsk.

National Forest Timber for Sale
Sealed bids will be received by the Regional Forester, Portland, Oregon, up to and including April 23, 1942 for all the live timber marked for cutting, and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 1,499 acres within Sections 20, 21, 28, 29, and 32, T. 28 S., R. 2 E., W. M., Umpqua National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 6,208,000 feet B. M., more or less, of sugar pine sawtimber, and an unestimated amount of Douglas-fir, California incense-cedar, Western redcedar, white fir and other species. No bid of less than \$7.80 per M feet for sugar pine, \$2.00 per M feet for Douglas-fir, \$1.50 per M feet for California incense-cedar, \$3.00 per M feet for Western redcedar, and \$5.00 per M feet for white fir and other species will be considered. In addition to the price bid for the stumpage, a cooperative deposit of \$55 per M feet B. M. to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash and snag disposal, and a cooperative deposit of \$20 per M feet B. M. to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing and forest improvement work on the area cut over, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. \$6,000.00 must be deposited with each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to conditions of sale. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and the submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Roseburg, Oregon, or the Regional Forester, Portland, Oregon.
