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Coos Coal To Boom

THE current interest and activity centering around the coal resource of Coos county is interesting to this part of Oregon for more reasons than one.

Although our first interest is the possibility of obtaining coal for fuel, the development of a great coal mining industry right next door, so to speak, will be of definite economic value to our area. There are definite signs that fuel is going to be both scarce and high priced this fall. Coal at a reasonable price will be a most welcome article.

There is unquestionably considerable coal beneath the top-soil in the Coos Bay area. There are known deposits also in our own county west of Drain. There should be a genuine coal mining industry developed in these regions. Nor has there ever been a more fortunate time for such development. The great cantonments being completed near Corvallis and near Medford will house, with their accompanying service units, nearly 100,000 men. Present fuel sources in the state are far from adequate to serve these great camps. They should use Coos Bay coal. Also favorable to the development of the bay coal is the fact that fuel will be a wanted item throughout the northwest this year. Miners had a meeting there recently to discuss plans for advertising and selling coal. That is a step in the right direction. We suggest (as onlookers, you might say) that the ability to produce a good product is as necessary a business as the ability to sell. Doubtless the Coos coal people are perfecting a marketing and shipping organization as well as sales plans.

The subject of transportation is something that should be discussed. The cost of shipping coal by rail from the production point to the new cantonments should be so adjusted as to give the nearer coal mines the benefit. Railroads are being hard worked in the war effort. They should not tolerate a rate structure that would put Washington coal into southern Oregon on a parity with coal produced in southwestern Oregon. And yet, unless we are badly misinformed, that is about the rate situation as it now exists. The railroad company need not be held to blame for this situation until it has been formally requested to correct it and has refused. Then, of course, a real complaint is due. The problem is a new one so its solution, with the reasonable cooperation from the railroad, should be easily accomplished. But unless Coos county coal gets reasonable freight rate treatment the industry will not grow. Coal is a bulky, heavy commodity that must move by rail or water. Transportation at reasonable rates is essential.

where) has already been made. It was probably made when Churchill was in this country. Important decisions such as this can't be left to the last minute.

All this talk from "informed" and "qualified" and other anonymous sources is designed to disturb and mislead the enemy as to just when and where the blow will fall.

It is part of a war of nerves which our side is trying out on Hitler and his pals, showing them that two can play at that game. When the decided-upon time comes, the second front (in one

form or another) will be launched.

THIS writer, basing his opinion upon the purest kind of guesswork, with no inside information to back it up, has an idea the second front will be opened when:

1. Russia's situation becomes desperate, or
2. The Russians have bled Germany white.

IN the first event, the second front would be opened in order to save Russia from destruction.

In the second event, it would be opened in order to move in on the already weakened Germans and give them the FINISHING BLOW.

THIS statement by "military sources" (also anonymous) in London is interesting as having a bearing on Contingency No. 1:

"The situation in southern Russia has not yet reached the point where a U. S.-British invasion of the continent is ESSENTIAL to save the Russian armies.

"The Russians, although speaking of German superiority of numbers, have given no indication of tapping extensively their OWN supposedly vast reserves."

In other words (according to this opinion) Russia's situation is NOT YET DESPERATE.

AS having a bearing on Contingency No. 2, this statement is quite interesting:

Stubborn Russian resistance to the German drive has forced Hitler to bring up reserves hurriedly from the rear to take the place of units put out of action. SEVERAL DIVISIONS that arrived only a few days ago FROM FRANCE AND BELGIUM have been observed in action on the Russian front.

If Hitler is being compelled to weaken his defenses along the Channel in order to BOLSTER his offensive in Russia, all is not going too well with him.

READ these rumors and opinions. Weigh one against another. Believe a little here and a little there, but don't swallow them ALL whole.

Remember that they are talk, permitted to pass the censorship for whatever effect they may have on the enemy.

What we are going to do, IF AND WHEN, is pretty well known by our higher command. That is what higher commands are for.

Concerning the NORTHWEST As Viewed at the National Capitol By John W. Kelly

WASHINGTON, D. C., July 17.

—Army and navy are taking the bit in their teeth and ignoring Elmer Davis, who is supposed to give the public all war information, and are now fighting Donald Nelson to see who will control production. As a dispenser of news Davis is licked already and probably he wishes he had back his \$20,000 job as a radio commentator. First, Mr. Davis proposed that the army and navy revise the method of revealing what is taking place in Alaska; come clean and tell the public the lowdown, keeping back of a military secret. Well, so far as Elmer Davis knew or the public was aware everything in Alaska, or the Aleutians was the deepest, darkest military secret. If army or navy had something good to report it comes out in a communique eventually; if there are reverses, there is no news for John Q. Citizen.

Every step in the invasion of America, via the Aleutians, became known through Japanese broadcasts. Spokesmen for the armed services discredited these broadcasts; began with vigorous denial that Japanese had obtained a foothold anywhere. Even now Japanese newscasters report additional transports with troops arriving in the Aleutians.

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
