2 lbs. lean lamb, 1 cup salt
2 cups salad oil 1/2 tsp. pepper
1/2 cup lemon juice 5 strips bacon
2 cups grated onion

Cut meat into 1-inch cubes. Let stand about 4 hours in marinade of oil, lemon juice, onion, and seasonings. Drain. Place cubes on skewers alternately with 1-inch squares of bacon. Place in drip pan. Brown 15 minutes in very hot oven (500° F.), turning once. Reduce to moderate oven (350° F.); continue baking 30 minutes, or until tender, basting frequently. Serve on skewers. Makes 8 kabobs.
