Wooden Bodies for Army Truck Being Turned Out

PORTLAND, Aug. 27.—(AP)—Oregon plants began turning out wooden army truck bodies this week, Ben E. Titus, of the Portland office of war information, said.

They were for standard army trucks and will replace steel bodies for which materials are becoming scarce.

Of the original 60,000 bodies ordered by the army, 6000 were awarded to contractors in this region. First pilot bodies were built here, in Eugene and Baker, and have already been accepted by the army. They were built of Douglas fir and ponderosa pine with laminated hardwood slats. Later it is expected that laminated fir and pine will replace the hardwood.

The original 6000 will be completed by about October 1 when it is expected that larger contracts will be awarded the Oregon firms Titus said.
