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News of Service Men

FREQUENTLY the News-Review receives communications relating to Douglas county men in various branches of military service. Often these letters include information which does not appear in print and we realize that writers must in some cases be concerned because facts included in the report were not published as submitted. This relates particularly to the identity of units with which men are serving overseas or vessels upon which men of the navy are on duty.

The News-Review is proud of its column devoted to news of service men. This pride comes from the fact that the department is so popular with our soldiers, sailors and marines, who have written us letters telling how they enjoyed hearing about their friends in service. Parents also have been kind enough to relay similar information which came from their sons to whom clippings had been enclosed in letters.

We particularly welcome any items concerning the Douglas county men in camps, on the sea or in any of the battle areas, and will be glad to publish all information that is permissible. News-papers throughout the United States, however, are operating under a voluntary code of censorship, in which they make every effort to publish all available news, while, at the same time, withholding information which might benefit the enemy.

The following statement, prepared for publication by the office of censorship, may be of particular interest to persons submitting news for publication as well as to those who may not have understood the reason for deletions in items published in the past.

"On battle fronts every day men risk their lives to discover the location and strength of the military units of the enemy. Yet at home, too many of us are presenting the enemy with information of the same military value."

"This is the information which newspapers and individuals are asked not to tell the enemy."

"Do not tell the names of ships upon which sailors serve."

"Do not tell the troop units in which soldiers serve overseas."

"There is no objection to revealing that Pvt. John Jones is in Australia or that Seaman Tom Brown saw action in the Atlantic, but there is military information in stating that Pvt. John Jones, 'Company C, 600th Infantry,' is in Australia, or Seaman Tom Brown, 'about the U. S. S. Wisconsin,' is in the Atlantic."

"We ask the editors not to publish these troop identifications, and we ask parents and relatives not to reveal them. Don't give the enemy anything that may lengthen the war."

The above quotation is from the statement of the office of censorship. For further clarification, it might be stated that there is no restriction on revealing the identity of units in established camps within the continental United States. Therefore, items pertaining to men still in the United States may carry information concerning their units, except in cases where they may be engaged in some active military operation, other than training, in transit, or in act of embarkation. Information on location of vessels or assignment of men to ships may be published only after having been released by the office of censorship. This frequently occurs after ships have returned to port, such as in the recent epic of the cruiser San Francisco.

If you are the wife, father, mother or other relative or close friend of a man in service we

will welcome information to be published concerning his whereabouts and activities. We know that his friends, both in and out of the service, will enjoy reading about him. The above word of caution, however, is given about revealing too much information, even in conversation. It is purely a reminder, for we realize that no one would purposely speak or write one word which might be of value to the enemy.

note that it forms a relatively narrow bottleneck, approximately 100 miles wide.

Back of this bottleneck, strung out from Stalingrad to the Caucasus mountains, are nearly a MILLION Germans.

These million Germans are facing entrapment. Your map will show you clearly how real the danger is.

THEY aren't trapped yet. And a million Germans, caught in a trap, can put up quite a fight. That is why the Russians are building a straight, strong, DEEP line as they advance.

But the situation that is shaping up holds possibilities of disaster for Hitler.

THERE'S a surprise in the recent news. British NAVAL aircraft make a heavy attack on Jap military targets at Sabang, at the northwestern tip of the former Dutch island of Sumatra. The planes were launched from a British naval force operating in the bay of Bengal.

The attack in itself isn't so important, but as serving notice to the Japs that the British have strong naval forces operating in that area it is highly interesting.

THERE are no new developments in Burma as this is written. The British bomb Akyab and the Japs bomb Calcutta. There were three Jap raiders and two of them were shot down. The Jap bombing of Calcutta is believed to be aimed at the morale of the Indian people.

AN interesting note comes from the south Seas.

American Flying Fortresses sink a Jap ship disguised with tree branches and foliage to make it resemble an island. It is sunk just off New Britain and is presumed to have been on its way to Buna, trying to get supplies to the Japs on the beaches.

The incident shows how closely we are watching Jap efforts to get in supplies there.

THERE are no new developments on the north African front, where the war on communications continues. Two axis warships and eight merchant vessels are reported sunk or damaged in efforts to get reinforcements across. The British land large reinforcements on Malta without encountering major interference from the enemy.

The fighting in Tunisia is hampered by rains, but there are claims of growing allied superiority in the air.

SENATOR McNary says that a republican and democratic advocates of economy in government will join forces in the new congress to "combat waste and bureaucracy."

More power to them. The more we WASTE in non-military activities the less we HAVE LEFT for our boys to fight with. They need all they can get.

Yule Holidays in Oregon Marked by 8 Violent Deaths

Eight violent deaths; seven on the highways, marked the Christmas holidays in Oregon.

Two automobiles collided in Portland yesterday, killing Mrs. George Zeasars, 41, Portland, and injuring three others.

In Klamath Falls, James A. Bowman, 44, died of injuries suffered in a light Christmas eve. District Attorney Sisemore said the fight started after a party.

Kenneth Walton, 44, was arrested on a charge of assault with a dangerous weapon. Sisemore said, after Bowman's death, he was preparing new charges.

Mr. and Mrs. William Beach, Prineville, died in the plunge of their automobile over an 80-foot embankment near Prineville. Apparently the car struck a washout in a newly constructed road.

Earlier, Raymond H. Olson, 39, Portland, was killed in a high-way crash near Brooks, and three other persons died in Portland traffic mishaps.
