Basketball fans of the Roseburg area will have an opportunity tonight to see the senior high school Indians in action in the first conference game of the season, when they meet the Medford Pear Pickers in the first of two local games starting at 7:30 p. m. The same teams will meet again Saturday night.

Coach Hod Turner has been drilling the team this week on offensive play, particularly on fast breaking formations designed to put players into position for scoring shots. The team is developing very rapidly, he reports, and should be able to make a satisfactory showing.

The test tonight will be the first among the southern Oregon teams composing the league, which this year has adopted two-game meetings as a method of reducing travel. The Indians will play return games at Medford February 5 and 6.

Flood Causes Damage In Elkton Community

ELKTON, Jan. 8.—The Umpqua river reached the 40-foot stage at the government gauge on the J. W. Gorman place during the recent flood, the high water resulting in considerable damage in the Elkton area. Mr. and Mrs. James Gourley reported that their ferry boat and cable were washed away. Mail stages were out of operation. Harry Weatherly narrowly escaped death or serious injury when he ran his automobile into a slide on the grade near the Charles Hedden property. While he was making an inspection of the roadway, a truck, driven by Forest Salomon also hit the slide, causing minor injuries to the driver and causing slight damage to the Weatherly car. A couple at Scottsburg reported being awakened by a noise to discover that the water had flooded the lower rooms of the house, tipping over a table. Their infant child was sleeping on a floating mattress.
