March Rainfall Here Just Below Normal

The month of March was just slightly below normal in rainfall and considerably above average in temperature, according to the monthly meteorological summary meteorologist in charge of the local station of the U. S. weather bureau.

The month showed temperature amounting to 2 degrees daily above the average. The lowest temperature recorded during the month was 27 degrees and the highest was 71 degrees.

NO MILK FROM A THEORY

EDITORIAL

A DELIBERATE smoke screen is being laid by the Office of Price Administration, with the aid of the Office of War Information, to counter the attack by the Oregon dairymen's committee, which is meeting in Portland to find ways and means of preventing complete collapse of the fluid milk industry.

The OPA and OWI "news releases" avoid any mention of the numerous dairy herds that have been lost, the distributors who have been forced to stop deliveries, and the diversion of butterfat from fluid milk to butter and other dairy products.

Already three Roseburg distributors have been forced to suspend retail deliveries and others are precariously maintaining milk routes. The same situation prevails throughout the state.

These facts are carefully ignored by the OPA and OWI in their news releases, which would cause the consumer to believe that all is rosy with the dairy industry, and that the producers and distributors are an unpatriotic bunch of people trying to gouge the public for excessive profits.

A statement released April 3 by the OWI for publication by newspapers points out that Oregon's cattle inventory on January 1, 1943, showed an increase; that good dairy cows are not being slaughtered and that dairy cow values are steadily increasing.

"Studies by OPA indicate that except in a few individual communities, increases in the price of milk to the consumer have failed to increase the overall supply of fluid milk," the OWI declares.

Typical of bureaucratic double-talk, that quotation is a sample of the effort to mislead the public with regard to the milk question.

There is no claim by the dairymen that increased prices will increase the total supply of milk. An increase on the ceiling price of butterfat, however, will make it possible for the continued production of fluid milk.

If we want milk to drink there must be an increase in price. The OPA can point with pride, if it likes, to the increased population of dairy cattle, but the fact still remains that the supply of whole milk is growing steadily less and producers and distributors alike are quitting business.

You get milk from a cow, not from an OPA theory.
