To the legal voters and taxpayers of the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon; that the Common Council of said city, will at its regular meeting to be held in the Council Chamber in said city at 7:30 p. m., Tuesday, July 6th, 1943, consider the adoption of an ordinance for the purpose of levying a general city tax in accordance with the laws of the state of Oregon; and at that time all legal voters and taxpayers interested will be given an opportunity to be heard upon the budget heretofore adopted by the budget committee of the city of Roseburg, and hereinafter set forth, and objections, if any, will be received by the Common Council at that time. Said budget being for the fiscal year beginning July 1st, 1943.

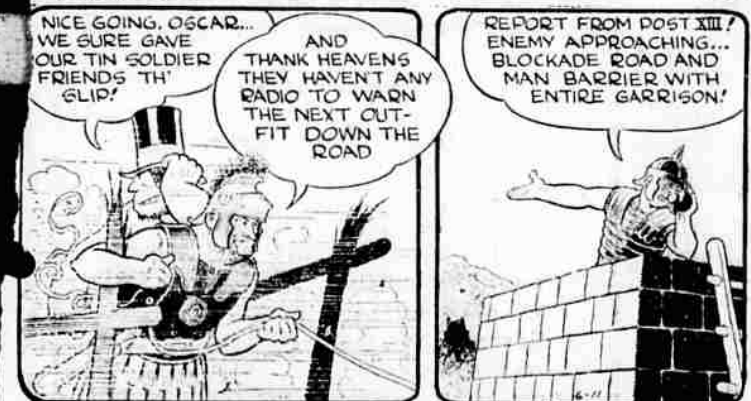
