RELIGION THRIVES IN ALLIED MILITARY RANKS

WASHINGTON—(AP)—The extent of religious activity within the armed forces is disclosed in the recent report of the office of chaplains. In one month, nearly 100,000 services were attended by more than 5 million persons. There were more than 4 million "pastoral contacts." In addition, the chaplains performed almost 4,000 marriages; received nearly 3,000 professions of religion and distributed nearly 500,000 religious articles, Testaments and Bibles. Further, 333 field reports were missing from this summary.
