Roosevelt Asks U. S. To Observe Columbus Day

WASHINGTON, Oct. 7 (AP)—President Roosevelt yesterday designated October 12 Columbus day in a proclamation which said it was especially fitting to honor a great Italian at a time "when the Italian people are striving to win back for themselves an honorable peace in the family of nations."

Asking the nation to observe the day, Mr. Roosevelt's proclamation said that "we who are determined to seek and to find high ways to a new world of peace and cooperation may take inspiration from the faith and courage of Christopher Columbus, who sailed across an uncharted sea and found a western continent and a new world."
