Sabotage Penalties Dealt Three Brothers
 CLEVELAND, Oct. 12.—(AP)—Federal District Judge Emerich B. Freed today sentenced the National Bronze & Aluminum Co.'s former president, John L. Schmeller, and the latter's two brothers, Edward and Frank, to ten years each in a penitentiary after a jury convicted them of violating wartime sabotage laws. The jurist also imposed fines of \$10,000 each on the three industrialists, refused to permit their release on bail, and denied motions for new trials. The brothers gave no outward evidence of emotion. Frank Schmeller was the concern's general manager, and Edward Schmeller was its chief metallurgist until relieved of their jobs in a company reorganization earlier this year.

Danish King Allowed to Retain Jewish Doctor
 STOCKHOLM, Oct. 13.—(AP)—The Germans at the personal request of King Christian X have released his personal physician, Prof. Eric Warburg, arrested in a round-up of Danish Jews, the free Danish Press Service said yesterday.

King Christian said he needed the services of Warburg, who is credited with saving the monarch's life during a summer illness. The word fahrenheit comes from Gabriel Daniel Fahrenheit, who invented the mercury thermometer in 1714.
