Huge Recovery Units Built For Salvaging Tanks

SEATTLE, Oct. 29.—(AP)—Col. K. B. Harmon, chief of the San Francisco ordinance district, today disclosed that monster recovery units, designed to rescue damaged tanks so they may be returned to battle, are being turned out at the Renton plant of the Pacific Car & Foundry Co.

They weigh 80 tons when fully loaded and can handle a 30-ton tank as if it were a cardboard box. They are designed to ramble across rough country and pick up tanks wherever they may be.

In a demonstration at the Renton test track, one of the huge vehicles drove off across stump land, maneuvered down a 30-degree incline and went to work on a General Sherman tank. The tailgate of the trailer unit was lowered, two steel cables were fastened to the tank; two winches snaked the tank on to the trailer bed. Then the unit crawled out of the gully with its load.

Each vehicle is test driven for 50 miles. The truck units are built here, the trailer units are made by the Fruehauf Trailer Co., in California and shipped here. After January 1, the retrievers will be assembled at the company's unit at Billings, Mont.

Foundry Workers Voting on Strike

SEATTLE, Oct. 28.—(AP)—Six thousand members of the AFL International Moulders and Foundry Workers union in 77 foundries in 16 Oregon and Washington cities will start taking a strike vote today.

The vote, which must be completed in eight days, comes after several months of wage controversy in which the union asked an increase of 25 cents an hour for most classifications. The labor board offered 3 cents increase for helpers, chippers, grinders and laborers and the union countered with a request for 8 cents.

The War Labor board said the foundries are turning out vital parts for aircraft and ship-building plants and that 15,000 would be affected by a strike.

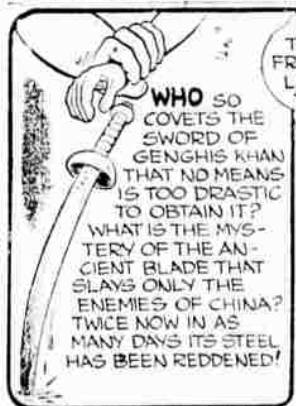

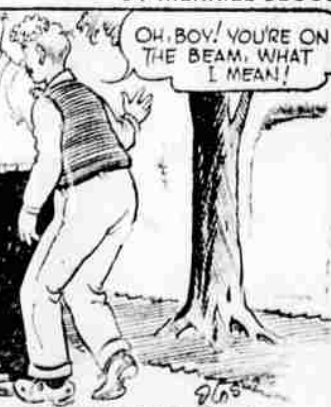
