### Douglas Survey Report Sent to Press, Agencies

A news release, containing a summary of the findings of the economic survey of Douglas county, has been sent by the Bonneville Power administration to 160 publications and agencies in 15 states and the District of Columbia, Harold J. Hickerson, secretary of the Umpqua Valley chamber of commerce at Roseburg, has been informed.

The news release calls attention to the survey's estimate of an 80 per cent increase in population through maximum development of potential resources. The item also points out the fact that the increase would tend to be permanent through operation of the sustained yield practice of timber management.
