THANKS TO GOVERNOR SNELL

GOVERNOR SNELL has added greatly to his political stature as the result of his appointment of Attorney Guy Cordon to succeed the late U. S. Senator Charles L. McNary.

Earl Snell would have been—and we hope may yet be—a capable United States senator. We share with him his confidence that he "could render a valuable and constructive service."

It requires a large measure of that quality which makes men great to reject an opportunity to fulfill a life-long ambition. The governor might have lost some political esteem and support had he availed himself of the power his office carries to advance arbitrarily to the United States senate.

The picture of men in positions of authority rising above the level of personal aggrandizement, subjugating self-interest to the welfare of the commonwealth, is a rarity in these days—anachronistic, in fact, with the mode in high places.

The overwhelming majority by which Earl Snell was elected to the office of governor attests the esteem in which he is held by Oregon voters.

The moot fact, which makes the appointment in the best interest of the state, is that no interim appointee could enter upon the work with greater foreknowledge of procedure and current issues than Cordon.

For more than 15 years Cordon has spent several months of each year in Washington. He has been working closely with the Oregon delegation.

Naturally, the residents of Douglas county rejoice in the honor bestowed upon Guy Cordon, who becomes the first United States senator ever to serve from this section of Oregon.

We have every confidence that Cordon will fill the office in a manner bringing credit to himself and to the state of Oregon and that Governor Snell will have no reason to regret his decision.

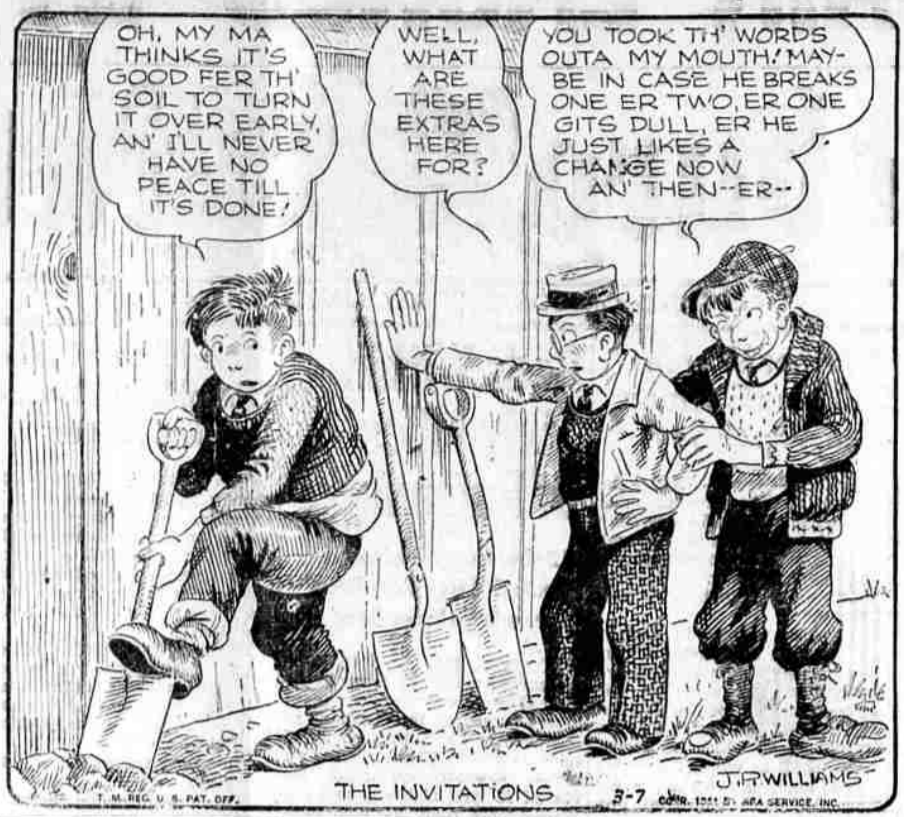
