## Mayor Harris Asks Public Cooperation In Price Control

Mayor W. H. Harris of Roseburg today called on individual members of the public to assist the local OPA price committee in their campaign to combat black market operations and price-ceiling violations in this community.

"The local board members have been given a great responsibility," he said, "and they have been frank enough to admit they cannot hope to accomplish the job effectively without the sincere and sustained support of the people."

"Personally, I feel that the majority of our retail merchants are complying with the price regulations, even in the face of their complexities. The board's price control committee shares this opinion."

Mayor Harris said the dealers who refuse to obey the regulations are doing a disservice, not only to the consumer and the war effort, but to their more honest and patriotic competitors.

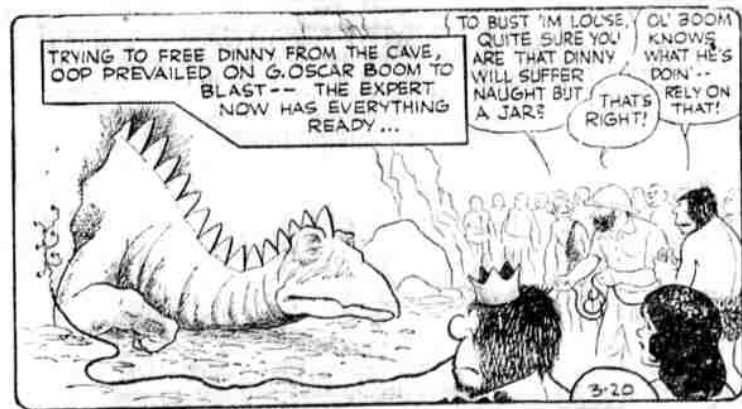

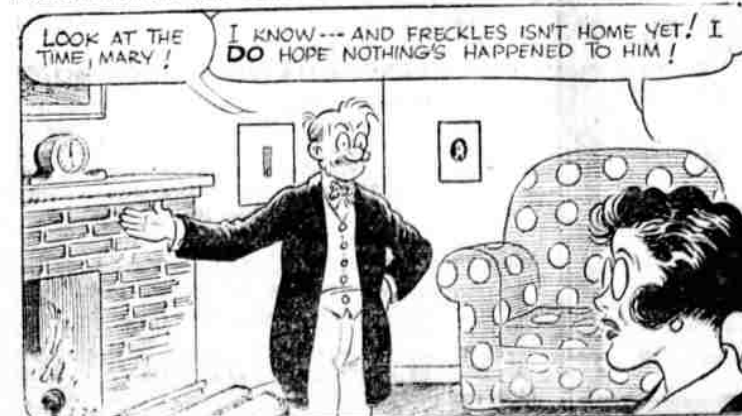
