

Arrests Fail to Curb Night Clubs

PORTLAND, Mar. 30. (AP)—The state liquor control commission today pondered the problem of illegal night clubs which flourish despite continual arrests.

The commission's enforcement division reported that 42 arrests had failed to daunt one group of owners.

"Continuing arrests and nominal fines have proved no deterrent," Vern Drager, enforcement supervisor, declared. "Bartenders arrested in several cases have put up bail and got back behind the bar, serving liquor, before the officer could finish his report and get back on his job."

Two possible solutions were suggested: Jail sentences for offenders, or impounding of furnishings in club found selling illegal liquor. Action of commission agents in stripping furnishings from two Portland clubs is now awaiting a court test.

Gas Cut Affects Sale of Hunting, Fishing Licenses

PORTLAND, Mar. 31. (AP)—An all time high of 139,078 fishing licenses and 126,147 hunting licenses issued in Oregon last year was reported by the state game commission today.

The commission added, however, that requests for licenses had fallen sharply since the last gasoline cut.
