Sealed bids will be received by the Regional Forester, Portland, Oregon, up to and including April 28, 1944, for all the live timber marked for cutting, and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 1,100 acres within Sections 17, 21 and 23, T. 29 S., R. 1 W., W. M., Umpqua National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 2,500,000 feet B. M., more or less, of sugar pine and an unestimated amount of ponderosa pine sawtimber plus such amounts of Douglas-fir, California incense-cedar, white fir and other species as are required to be cut because of logging damage or are incidentally cut in the course of logging. In addition, there is upon the advertised area and available for cutting at the option of the purchaser, an estimated volume of 5,000,000 feet B. M., more or less, of Douglas-fir and 200,000 feet B. M., more or less, of California incense-cedar, white fir and other species of sawtimber. No bid of less than \$8.00 per M. feet for sugar pine, \$3.00 per M. feet for ponderosa pine, \$2.90 per M. feet for Douglas-fir, \$1.00 per M. feet for California incense-cedar, white fir and other species will be considered. Agreement as a part of the bid to take all or definite amounts of optional material will be considered in the award. In addition to the prices bid for the stumpage, a co-operative deposit of \$55 per M. feet B. M. to be made by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash and snag disposal, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. \$4,000.00 must be deposited with each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to conditions of sale. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and the submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Roseburg, Oregon, or the Regional Forester Portland, Oregon. Bids with rates in excess of those permissible under MPR 460 will be reduced to the allowable maximum in making the award.
