voys seeking to reach Romanian ports. The Russians said bombers attacked two convoys Monday night, sinking a 3,000-ton transport and another of 2,000 tons, and on the following day swooped on two more convoys, sinking a 5,000-ton transport and numerous smaller ships and barges. Axis troops jamming the Sevastopol docks were being pounded by Russian artillery commanding nearby heights, the dispatches added. A dispatch from Associated Press Correspondent Henry C. Cassidy in Odessa quoted Rear Admiral Beluzov, commandant at that base, as saying that American and British equipment, particularly planes, was being used by the Black sea fleet. In the present phase of the battle for Sevastopol, the admiral declared, the red fleet has "ships of all classes" at its disposal while the Germans possess nothing larger than a destroyer. Southwest of Tarnopol in the western Ukraine minor battles of local importance were reported yesterday.

mill. In the field of utilization of wood waste, the Northwest needs plants to produce alcohol, sugar, resins, impregnated woods, plywood, plastics and fabrics.

World Coming to Douglas "The world is coming to Douglas county because you have the resources," Dr. Raver said. He pointed out the depletion of timber along tidewater in the state of Washington, reporting that 100 mills will close down in that area as soon as war contracts are cancelled.

"The lumber industry is moving your way," he told his audience. "You must produce the leadership to establish a wood products industry rather than a mere logging operation. Statistics show that in the past 50 per cent of the trees felled in the woods have been wasted. That means the end of the logging industry in Washington comes 50 per cent too soon. You have the opportunity to secure greater utilization of your timber resources, and, through sustained yield, to establish a permanent industry." The problem of utilization of wood waste again returns to the matter of attracting industry through cheap and abundant power, he asserted.

New Markets Planned Dealing with the postwar problems, he said that the closing of war industries would cut Bonneville gross revenue from \$20 million to \$6 million annually. "We have built a great industrial machine to kill our enemies; there is no reason why it cannot be converted to produce for peace," he declared. He told of work being done to plan new markets for power following the war, outlining as one of the great possibilities the use of electric energy for heating in homes and offices, a new development which is being proved practical and economical in actual test. Last night's dinner meeting, sponsored by the Roseburg chamber of commerce, was attended by a capacity audience. The speaker was introduced by Earl Wiley, chamber of commerce president.

Italy Areas Blasted

Allied warplanes, diverted temporarily from assaults on Balkan rail targets, smashed at German communications in Italy yesterday, with U. S. bombers blasting Venice harbor and pounding other targets from Ancona to Trieste. The big bombers were hampered by clouds, but explosives fell close to a merchant vessel in Venice harbor and other undisclosed targets were hit, headquarters said. The Montalcone shipyards near Trieste and the port of Livorno (Leghorn) also were attacked. In all, allied planes yesterday destroyed 10 German craft for a loss of eight of their own. Heavy artillery duels raged again in the Cassino area where patrols also were very active. About 60 German planes were observed over the battlefronts yesterday.

ferred the ravages of one of the worst famines in China's famine history, and who subsequently were afflicted by plagues of locusts and floods. Along Japan's Pacific outposts, allied air power continued its hammering, featured by the third consecutive daily attack on Wake island in the western Caroline islands and the important Satawan airstrip 150 miles southeast of Truk in the eastern Carolines. Adm. Nimitz told of a 46-ton attack on Truk Wednesday, the 25th blow there since Truk was hit for the first time Feb. 16. Other central Pacific planes pounded Ponape, east of Truk; Wake island and four by-passed enemy bases in the Marshalls.
