

Point Value On Butter To Be Reduced

Margarine Also Slated For Slash in May; Choice Beef Cuts Up Slightly

WASHINGTON, April 27—(AP)—Butter will be reduced to 12 red points a pound effective Sunday, through June 3, Price Administrator Chester Bowles announced Wednesday.

Butter has been 16 points since October.

The same order cut the ration price of margarine from 6 to 2

red points, also effective Sunday.

Point value for farm or country butter will be reduced to 8 points per pound and processed butter from 6 points to 4.

Shortening, lard, salad and cooking oils continue point-free in May.

Beef Points to Go Up

Points for choice cuts of beef go up slightly next month, but lamb and mutton points will be reduced 50 per cent to permit quicker distribution of shipments of light weight lambs because of drought conditions. Veal points remain the same and pork about the same as for April.

Most steak goes up a point a pound because of demands. Flank steak, however, will be reduced from 12 points to 10. Rib round tip and rump (bone in) beef roasts go up 1 point a pound, but rump boneless roasts will be 2 points lower. Hamburger will stay at 6 points.

Lamb and mutton steaks and chops will be reduced 3 and 4 points, roast 2 and 3, steaks and other cuts 2.

Lamb and mutton breast, flank, neck and shank will be point-free for the month.

Spareribs will go back on rationing at one point a pound at the request of meat trade, which reported supplies sold too fast and inequitably while they were

The teams battled on even terms at 3-all after the third inning until Second Baseman Calteaux singled in the fifteenth and Pitcher Chet Johnson sacrificed him to second. The Padres put on the hit-and-run and Third Baseman Wheeler's grounder went through short to bring in the winning tally. Wheeler went to second on the throw to the plate and scored a moment later when Morgan, Padre shortstop, rapped another through the middle.

The Beavers tried hard to retrieve the game, two pinch hitters singling after two were out, but Johnson struck out Heddington, the third Beaver pinchhitter.

At Seattle the Rainiers opened their home season with a night win over the Sacramento Solons, 8 to 0. Pitcher Demoran held the Solons to four hits in chalking up his third win against one defeat for the season.

The San Francisco Seals-Hollywood Star contest went one scoreless inning before the umpire decided baseball could not be played in the downpour.

Browns Tie Yanks In Victory Streak At Season's Start

At the rate those unbeaten St. Louis Browns are going they're likely to finish second in the American league. Nobody's out in front of them or even close behind, but old man precedent says they can't win the pennant.

When the Browns stopped Cleveland, 5-2, yesterday they tied the Yankees' 1933 league record for most consecutive games won at the start of a season, with seven. However, the New Yorkers of that happy April eleven years ago wound up seven games behind Washington in October.

Nine is the modern high mark in the national but the co-headers, the New York Giants of 1918 and the Brooklyn Dodgers of 1940, were only second place also-rans to the Chicago Cubs and Cincinnati Reds respectively.

These figures probably weren't worrying Luke Sewell a bit after Steve Sundre's second victory. Though touched for ten hits, Sundre pitched shutout ball until after the Browns' four-run sixth inning uprising marked by Don Guttridge's triple and Vernon Stephens' two-run double.

Borowy Wins 9th Straight

Hank Borowy also joined the ranks of two-time winners as the Yankees squared the series with Philadelphia, 6-2. He now has won nine successive league games since last August 10 in addition to one world series and two

exhibition triumphs. Hank allowed 11 hits, but Nick Etten thumped the A's into submission with a two-run homer, a double and single.

Early Wynn and Gil Torres took the bows in Washington's 2-1 edge over Boston. Wynn allowed only six hits, all singles, in hanging up win No. 2 and Torres, the Cuban third baseman, rapped out a double and single, driving in both runs scored off Yank Terry.

Bucky Walters knows now that Cincinnati can score but he might have been inclined to doubt it after pitching 21 innings over a two-game stretch during which the Reds did not cross home plate. Frank McCormick finally broke it up with a 13th inning home run giving Cincinnati and Walters a 1-0 nod over Rookie Alvin Jurisch of the St. Louis Cardinals.

Vince DiMaggio kept the old family name in the headlines by

collecting a home run with two men on and a double in Pittsburgh's 6-1 pummeling of Chicago. Frenchie Rose coasted in with a seven-hitter after a five-run Pirate sport in the sixth.

Detroit-Chicago in the American and Brooklyn-Boston in the National were postponed because of cold and rain. The Giants and Phils were not scheduled.
