

Baruch Donates Fund for Medical Aid to War Vets

NEW YORK, April 28—(AP)—Bernard M. Baruch has donated \$1,000,000 for promotion of "physical medicine," especially for treatment of returning war veterans, and says that "it works out, I am prepared to put most of my fortune into it—I believe in it."

Physical medicine makes use of massages, water, light, heat, cold electricity, occupational pursuits, exercises, muscular manipulations and various mechanical devices in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases.

"I am convinced," Baruch said, "that returning men and women now in the armed forces will need the advantages of physical medicine, and I feel that this program will help restore discharg-

ed soldiers to normal physical and mental condition.

The 73-year-old financier, who for years was chairman of the commission which developed Saratoga Springs, N. Y., into an internationally famous spa, gave his donation in honor of his late father, Dr. Simon Baruch, to be used over a 10-year period for research and for training technicians.

He said he was impressed with the possibilities of physiotherapy, by his father, who was graduated from the Medical College of Virginia in 1862, served as a surgeon with the confederate army, and later taught at the College of Physicians and Surgeons.

Australia Grateful for U. S. Aid, Curtin States

WASHINGTON, April 27—(AP)—Prime Minister Curtin of Australia says he and President Roosevelt are in "complete harmony."

In a radio address, a review of

war and postwar problems in the Pacific, Curtin said last night he has expressed to Mr. Roosevelt the gratitude of the Australian people for American aid in preserving their country from Japanese aggression and added: "Australia will look to the United States in the future, as it will look to the other great powers with the greater resources, to work out, internationally, the salvation of human beings."

But Australia's voice, Curtin said, will be heard in the Pacific and it will accept its responsibilities.
