Medal Awarded
Maj. W. H. Cloake,
Missing in Action

Marine Major Wallace H. Cloake of Roseburg, Ore., who has been reported missing in action since last September 18, has been awarded the Air Medal with a presidential citation, marine corps headquarters announced today.

His citation reads: "For meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight as a member of Marine Fighting squadron 213 in action against enemy Japanese forces in the Solomon Islands area from June 18 to July 18, 1943. "Directing his four-plane group of fighters on two vital assignments over Rendova Island and Kula gulf, Major Cloake courageously launched daring, determined attacks against large numbers of enemy aircraft and, despite overwhelming odds, personally destroyed one hostile fighter on each occasion.

"On another mission his flight, escorting nine bombers, intercepted approximately 30 Zeros and, under his outstanding leadership, prevented them from attacking our striking force.

"Major Cloake's expert flying skill and aggressive fighting spirit throughout numerous combat missions contributed greatly to the success of his division and were in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States naval service."

Major Cloake's wife, Mrs. Rachel Arthur Cloake, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Elvin G. Cloake, live at Route 2, Roseburg.
