**BUTTER, CHEESE "TAKE" UP** With milk production expected to reach its yearly peak during May and June, the War Food Administration is increasing its "take" of butter and cheddar cheese for the armed forces and other war needs. Manufacturers will be required to set aside 60 per cent of their cheese production for both months. The butter set aside is 40 per cent of the May production and 50 per cent of the June output. For both products, the set-aside percentages are increased from March and April, but less than for the comparable months in 1943, so that civilian supplies are expected to be somewhat larger than for the same period last year.
