

Mexican Labor In Oregon Short Of Farm Requests

All of the approximately 3100 Mexican workers allotted to Oregon for work in June and early July have been allocated to counties up to the middle of July, making it impossible to fill additional current requests for these workers, says J. R. Beck, state supervisor of emergency farm labor for the O. S. C. extension service.

Although the number of these Mexican nationals who will help harvest Oregon's crops has been increased 40 per cent over last June, the quota actually is 1200 short of requests which had been approved by the state farm labor service and certified to the office of labor of the War Food administration, Beck reported.

Approximately 1000 Mexicans are now engaged in farm work in Oregon and about 2000 more will arrive directly from Mexico at various times between June 5 and 30. These will be distributed and assigned to peak labor areas as they arrive, Beck said.

More than 90 per cent of the Mexican workers are under contract to county sponsoring committees and are allocated to various growers on the basis of need.
