2 Performances Of Bond Aid Show Set for Roseburg

Because of the unexpectedly heavy demand for tickets for the Fifth War Loan Bond Show at the Indian Theater Wednesday night, it has become necessary to arrange two performances, it was announced today by the war bond committee. More than enough tickets already have been sold to fill the theater for one performance and there is every indication the demand will exhaust available seats prior to the arrival of the all-army cast from Camp White, Medford.

The theater seats 760 people, which limits ticket sales to 1,520 for the two performances.

Tickets are being given free to all persons exhibiting a bond or bond purchase receipt at the Fifth War Loan headquarters, Cass and Jackson street, or at the theater box office.

Thriller Is Scheduled
Featuring the entertainment will be the stage show "The Call of Freedom," a dramatic production which has thrilled audiences in every community where it has been presented. Written by two soldiers at Stockton field, California, the Camp White version is played by ten experienced actors from the Little Theater group. Producer and director is Corporal Dean Nelson, formerly a Pasadena Playhouse actor. The dramatic stage show, which depicts in three scenes the memories of a soldier coming back from the war to a strange America, will be augmented by the new screen hit, "Two Girls and a Sailor," a musical comedy with all-star cast.

The 30-piece military band from Camp White will play street concerts preceding each show.
