Processor's Ceiling

Prices for Apricots Set

WASHINGTON, July 3.—(AP)—Processor's ceiling prices for the 1944 pack of canned and frozen apricots in states other than California will be constructed to include for raw-product cost an average grower price of \$79 a ton if the size of the fruit is about normal.

The War Food administration and the OPA announcing the action, said that apricots for canning and freezing in Washington and Oregon would bring \$85 a ton for grade 1 and \$51 a ton for grade 2.

Grower prices for California apricots were announced earlier in the week.

The WFA said the producer and processor support program covering peaches and pears for canning would be extended to apply to canning apricots.

Son Is Born To Wife Of Finnish Minister

WASHINGTON, July 5.—(AP)—A son was born early Monday to Madame Hjalmar Procope, wife of the former Finnish minister to the United States.

The minister was handed his passport by the state department last month with the announcement that the action had been taken because of actions "inimical" to the interests of the United States.

Later the state department said Procope might remain here until his third child was born, but he left as soon as possible with most of his staff. Madame Procope remained here.
