Japs Say Guam Heavily Raided by U. S. Planes

NEW YORK, July 12—(AP)—The Tokyo radio in a broadcast reported today by the federal communications commission, said that between July 1 and 10 "770 enemy aircraft" had raided Guam and admitted that "some damage was suffered by our side."

The broadcast asserted 94 of the planes had been downed—a claim totally unsubstantiated by American announcements of air losses at Guam.

A later Tokyo broadcast, also recorded by FCC, quoted an imperial headquarters communique as saying that the Japanese air force in the China area had "shot down" 11 United States planes between July 3 and 11 against a loss of seven planes.
