Gen. "Beedle" Smith, Descendant of Prussian Soldier, as Eisenhower's "Shadow" Makes Dreams Come True

LONDON - What does it take to be an "ideal chief of staff?" The answer is to be found in Lt. Gen. Walter Bedell "Beedle" Smith, tart-tongued "shadow commander" of the Allied Expeditionary Forces. For that is how Gen. Dwight D. "Ike" Eisenhower describes his chief of staff, Eisenhower says he knows only four men in the American army capable of being great chiefs of staff and "Beedle," as he calls his assistant, is the best of the four. That "Ike's" opinion is shared by Gen. Marshall is seen in the fact that Marshall gave "Beedle" the important post as secretary to the combined chiefs of staff and the American Army general staff. Before Eisenhower requested Smith's assignment to Europe, the chief of staff was almost never heard from in warfare. He is the usual "shadow" for the supreme commander, seeing to it that the commander-in-chief's policies are carried out in detail. Hard, Often Thankless Job Eisenhower said the commander's relation to his chief of staff is the same as that of a man who aims his car at a distant objective and the man who drives it, watching out for ruts and bumps coming up before the objective is reached. It's a tough, hard and often thankless task and 999 out of every
