Trout Farm Site Will be Improved By New Owners

REEDSPORT, Ore., Aug. 14 - Attracted by the beauty of its setting and the possibilities as a riverfront recreational center, John F. Branson and his wife, Evelyn, have closed a deal with William H. and Belle Harris in which the Bronsons will take possession of the property on the Umpqua river about 11 miles east of this city, known as "Bill's Trout Farm". The site is in the Umpqua river gorge with considerable frontage on the river and extends across the county road and up the hillside to the south, where a beautiful artificial trout lake nestles in a small creek running into the river.

Mr. and Mrs. Bronson are owners and operators of the West Coast Victory Carnival company, which has been showing to towns in the Oregon country this season. They were attracted to the lower Umpqua valley by literature distributed at the Treasure Island World Fair in San Francisco, and kept a lookout for a likely site for a home and recreational center while touring the coast country this season. Bill's Trout Farm on the Umpqua attracted their attention as a beautiful and recreational spot and they immediately commenced negotiations for its purchase.

Mr. and Mrs. Bronson will turn the property over to the new owners November 1, but will continue in charge until after the first of the year.
