

Naval Repair Unit Seeks Men Here

Kenneth L. Fordham, recruiting representative for west coast navy yards, arrived in Roseburg last night and will remain through Monday recruiting labor to serve in naval repair work. He is making his headquarters at the U. S. employment service office in the courthouse from 8 a. m. to 5 p. m.

All types of labor is critically needed in the naval yards and there are ample openings for both men and women, Fordham states. Skills are not required.

Workmen serve under rules and regulations of the Civil Service commission and the War Manpower commission. Free transportation and meals are furnished en route to the job. Applicants need no birth certificate. No competitive examinations are required. Physical standards have been modified to permit employment of any able bodied person. Pull particulars are available to any interested person through interview with the recruiting representative.

Red Drive Into Romania Ignores Bid for Peace

Germany was captured. German announced officially today that "some Romanian troops had stopped fighting, and Moscow dispatches told of widespread local engagements between Nazi rear guards and King Mihai's army, thrown to the allied side by the Balkan kingdom's abrupt capitulation and reversal.

Bulgaria Wants Peace. Outrunk Bulgaria intensified its search for peace, and London speculated that a capitulation from the Bulgarians would come shortly. Hungary's boundaries were barred to the advancing Russians and, according to Bucharest broadcasts, to the Romanians too.

The liberation of adjoining Yugoslavia and nearby Greece were brought infinitely closer. Even Finland, far to the north, was reported in new peace overtures. Romanians, who previously had deserted, told advancing Russian troops that "Germans machine-gunned them for retreating and that they, the Romanians, in turn, killed their Nazi military masters."

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Continued Unity In Peace Planning Urged by F. D. R.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 24—(AP)—President Roosevelt told the delegates to the Dumbarton Oaks security conference yesterday that he hopes "in planning for the peace that is to come we will arrive at the same good cooperation and unity of action as we have in the carrying on of the war."

Asserting that "we learn from experience," Mr. Roosevelt greeted the 42 delegates on a visit to the White House by expressing his hope for success in their work on a plan for postwar security.

"It is something new, this close relationship between the British empire and the United States," he said. "This great friendship between the Russian people and the American people—that is new. Let's hang on to both friendships, and by spreading that spirit of unity and cooperation, that we may have a peaceful world for our grandchildren to grow up in."

The president said one of the things this and other conferences must work out is "something that will last, last a long time."

Nazi Youth Big Problem. Mr. Roosevelt recalled a conversation with Secretary of War Stimson, and said Stimson told him that "unfortunately, in Germany, the young people, the young Nazis favor an idea which will be dangerous to the peace of the world just as long as they have anything to say about it."

"The prisoners of 17, 18, 20 that we are capturing now—both the French front and the Soviet front—these German prisoners of that age are even worse in their nature than the prisoners of 40 or 45," Mr. Roosevelt said. "And, therefore, as long as these young men have anything to say about it, the peril of nazism will always be before us."

"And we have got to make not merely a peace, but a peace that will last, and a peace in which the larger nations will work absolutely in unison in preventing war by force. But the four of us have to be friends, conferring all the time—the basis of getting to know each other—putting their feet upon the table."

Later Wednesday, a flew to Paris in a reconnaissance aircraft. Other planes ahead of us over the city were dodging balloons and heavy ack-ack batteries, indicating then that the French control of the city was not complete.

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French Hussies Given Head Shaves

CHARITRES, France, Aug. 16—(AP)—These episodes of the French shearing the hair off their women is a manifestation of mob spirit which is peculiarly supported by many elements of the French nation, but there are also many people who deplore the incidents.

I watched today as 30 unhappy women submitted to head shavings because they were afraid of the jeering, yelling mob behind them. Afterward they were led in shame through the streets.

Most of them were lumpy, ugly creatures who certainly contributed no great distinction on the Nazis by consorting with enemy occupation troops.

Yet the French have reasons for hating these women.

"We felt that France was truly ended when our women—even these women—took up with the Germans," said one Frenchman.

A French major with four rows of ribbons on his chest without the women being shaved in his gray eyes.

"We hate them because Frenchmen are dead because of these women," he said.

He and other Frenchmen believe that the gossip of these women to German soldier friends led to the capture and death of many resistance leaders.
