

Applicants For Houses Urged To Complete Blanks

Persons who recently applied to the National Housing administration for permission to construct homes in Roseburg and vicinity and who were furnished application blanks Sept. 15 by the NHA must complete their applications by Nov. 1, or take chances with other applicants who will be treated on a first-come, first-served basis, James

E. Maxwell, district housing representative, reported today.

Twenty-nine individuals recently filed their intentions to construct 41 housing units, Maxwell reports, and all were furnished with application forms. To date, however, only three persons have completed applications, authority having been given for construction of nine units. L. E. Fender has applied for seven units and C. R. Conrad and Wm. DeVancy have each applied for one unit.

Allotments will be held open for listed applicants only until Nov. 1, Maxwell said. Persons who have application forms which they have not completed should fill out the blanks and re-

turn them at once if they still desire to engage in home construction.

After Nov. 1 any priorities not allocated will be given to qualified applicants in the order in which applications are received, he said.

Mr. Maxwell was accompanied to Roseburg by Arthur Van de Sys, Seattle, regional home use director of the NHA.

Reforestation Backed by Union Of Woodworkers

VANCOUVER, B. C., Oct. 25. (CP)—Reforestation as both a postwar employment project and a conservation measure was urged in the officers' report adopted by the International Woodworkers of America annual convention here today.

The report said that forests now provide one-half the industrial jobs in the northwest, and that more than half of the old-

growth timber had been cut or wasted.

"We can have an expanding economy and stability in the forest industries only by rebuilding and improving forest resources and by regulating their exploitation," the report stated.

The convention presented a five-point forestry program: Replanting; reduction of fire hazards by thinning out of areas already reforested; regulation of logging methods; extension of public control over forest lands, and development of new uses for wood products.

Complaint was made in the report that when prisoners of war were placed in logging camps the standards of housing

and working conditions required had to be raised substantially in certain states.

"This means," the report said, "that free American workmen in the woodworking industry were living in camps under conditions that did not meet the minimum requirements of placing war prisoners in industry."

Emphasizing need for improved safety measures in the industry, "most hazardous of all," the report recommended legislation "to permit the widest application of rehabilitation plans to enable injured workmen, in the wood-working or other industries, to secure adequate training so that

they may go into lines of work that they are able to do."
