RHS Basketeers Walloped, 35 to 16, By Cottage Grove

Complete reorganization of the Roseburg High school basketball team, with emphasis upon sophomores to build up strength for next year, was being seriously considered today by Coach Mel Ingram following a 35-to-16 defeat administered by the Cottage Grove Lions to the Roseburg Indians in a game at Cottage Grove last night.

Discouraged over the prospects for this season as a result of the poor showing by the Indians to date, Ingram stated he is seriously considering revamping the squad, abandoning any attempt to compete for top standings in this year's league play, but building for the future.

Friday night, the Indians will be pitted against Eugene high in the Roseburg court. Eugene has the toughest team in the league, with five lettermen from last year. The Axemen are in top spot. Against this kind of competition Ingram reports he is planning to send in two complete teams, one composed of the sophomores and from the outcome will determine future policy.

The loss to Cottage Grove last night put the Indians in the cellar spot.

Roseburg trailed all the way, and was down 14 to 6 at half time.

The Roseburg B team defeated the Cottage Grove second string, 30 to 15, Bill Marsters leading the scoring with 15 points.

The Indians in the main game made their poorest showing of the year, both on offense and defense.
