PRICE CONTROL

PROCESSED FOODS:
BOOK 4—Blue stamps 23 through 25, 27, 28-32, valid indefinitely. Blue stamps C-3 through G-2 valid Monday, January 1.

MEAT, BUTTER, CHEESE
BOOK 4—Red stamps 23 through 33 valid indefinitely. Red stamps 75 through 93 valid on Sunday, December 31.

SUGAR:
BOOK 4—Sugar stamp 34 valid indefinitely, 3 pounds.

SHOES: Loose stamps invalid.

BOOK 3: Airplane stamps 1-2-3 valid indefinitely.

GASOLINE COUPONS: Not valid unless endorsed.

1-4 expires March 21, 1945. Each coupon worth 4 gallons.

STOVES:
Apply local board for oil, gas stove certificates.

WOOD, COAL, SAWDUST:
Delivery by priorities based on needs.

FIRE OIL:
