Orville R. Sanders, S. P. Ry. Conductor, Claimed by Death

Orville Roy Sanders, 61, well-known resident of Roseburg and Southern Pacific R. E. conductor, died at Mercy hospital in Portland following a short illness. He was born at Dale, Indiana, January 2, 1884, and came to Roseburg in 1912. He was married to Belle Scott at Vancouver, Washington, on June 28, 1921. Mr. Sanders had been engaged in railroad work for the past 41 years, and has been with the Southern Pacific company since 1916. He was a member of the Eagles lodge and the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen.

Surviving besides his widow are two children, Morgan C. Sanders, Sheridan, Oregon, and James A. Sanders, Roseburg. He is also survived by two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held in the chapel of the Douglas Funeral Home Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Dr. Charles A. Edwards officiating. Concluding services and interment will follow in the Masonic cemetery.

Alfred Duncan of Canyonville Dies

Alfred C. Duncan, 75, well-known resident of Canyonville, died at his home Sunday, May 2, 1889, at Jacksonville, Oregon. He was married at Klamath Falls, Oct. 28, 1905, to Mamola Gilmore. Mr. and Mrs. Duncan spent five years in Klamath county, then moved to Canyonville.
